Microaggressions: How does acting out on racial implicit bias perpetuate the problem? Special Guest: Dr. Rebecca A. Yazzie

Dr. Rebecca A. Yazzie is a licensed clinical social worker and has been serving various populations for just under twenty years working with adolescents, adults and families in a variety of settings. These settings include schools, community, crisis response, institutions, and criminal justice arenas. The majority of her 15 years of clinical work has been with individuals seeking support to navigate life challenges and difficult experiences. She has a demonstrated commitment to collaborating with individuals and agencies seeking support and dialogue to enhance their wellness.

Currently, Rebecca is an Associate Professor of Social Work at George Fox University. She teaches courses in the master of social work program ranging from direct practice courses to special topics including substance abuse, neurobiology and trauma. She has been teaching in higher education since 2007 and has a passion for teaching and facilitating growth and development with professionals in social services, public service agencies and nonprofits.
